

# Ready to Fly Check

1

Apply for entry visa.



This is needed for entry.

2

Book your first night at a hotel.



This is needed for entry.

3

Print return airline ticket.



This might be needed for entry.

4

Book airport taxi pick-up.



For most westerners, India is a culture shock. Make sure your arrival goes safely and smoothly.

5

Get the necessary vaccinations.



Most countries have a Tropical Institute where you can inquire about the pertinent vaccinations.

6

Get travel insurance.



It is unlikely you will need it, but it will give you peace of mind.

7

International driver's license.



We do not recommend you drive, but if you want to you will need an international driver's license to do so legally.

8

Enable your bank cards.



Most bank cards are locked for certain geographical regions, so make sure you let your bank know you're going to India. Also ATMs are available almost everywhere, so no need for huge amounts of cash.

9

Make a copy of all essential documents.



My mother always made me do this. Although I never had to make use of it, I have seen people sweat because they did not do it. I recommend both a scanned (sent to your own email) and printed copy. Include your passport, credit card, bank card (and helpline phone number), insurance info, driver's license, and return ticket.
