

Have it handy as you will need it to for the entry form.



If you get thirsty after fights, make sure to buy enough water before you board the airplane to India. From arrival to the next bottle of water can take up to 1



I highly recommend buying a SIM card at the airport. It will make communication home much cheaper and within India much easier. Outside the airport it is virtually impossible for foreigners to get SIM cards. (IDEA is the only provide with 3G, SIM plus one month 3G appprox. 1000 INR).



If you planned a head you will find a taxi driver with a sign with your name on it. If not, you will wish you had done so;) (Approx. 1060 INR)



You will need it for the entry form.




Once you get to immigration make sure you're standing in the line for foreigners, otherwise you might wait for nothing.



To buy the SIM card and pay the driver you will need some cash. Money exchange can be found inside the Airport. The ATM is just out side the doors.



The next easiest way to get to The Sand Castle is to take a pre paid taxi. The counter for this is inside the airport. (Approx. 900 INR, plus tip)



There is also a bus service. If you're brave and on a low budget you can take it, but I don't recommend it for first timers or anyone else for that matter.
